2. List the accomplishments of Barnabas in this passage (vv. 11:22-26)
  
3. Who called the disciples Christians? What does the word Christian mean?
  
4. What was done for “the brethren dwelling in Judea”? Why?

### B. The Persecution by Herod (12:1-25)

1. How is Christian persecution in chapter 12 (vv.1-2) different from previous Christian persecution in chapters 7 and 8? (see vv. 8:1-3)
  
2. Why did Herod want to seize Peter? What precaution did Herod take so that a repeat of chapter 5:17-23 would NOT happen?
  
3. Describe the death of Herod. How did he die?
