

# The Book Of Acts - Chapter 3

## Continuing Part 1: The Witness in Jerusalem (1:1-8:4)

### II. The Progress of the Church (1:1-2:47)

#### A. Peter Heals the Lame Man (3:1-11)

1. What do we know about the man that Peter and John encounter in 3:2?  
(see 4:22 as well)
2. What was the need he was asking for? (vv.2-5)
3. Peter saw the man's obvious physical need; but what greater and deeper need did Peter see and want to meet? (vv.4-6)

So what did Peter give to the lame man? (vv.6-7)

4. How did the man respond to what he received?

Was it a worthy response? (vv.8-10; see also 4:1-3; 5-7;13-14)

5. How did the people react to what had happened? (vv.9-11)

#### B. Peter's Second Sermon (3:12-26)

1. To whom did Peter give all the glory for what was done? (vv.12-13,16)
2. What did Peter accuse his audience of doing? (vv.13-15)
3. What does it mean to "repent and be converted"? (v.19)

(NOTE: "be converted" (KJV), is "turn back" (ESV), "return" (NASV), "turn to God" (NIV). Peter echoes the voice of the OT prophets stated concisely in Ezek 33:11.)

4. What had Samuel and all the prophets foretold?
