Isaiah Chapter 2

- 1) What will be the status of Jerusalem and the temple mount in this prophetic *vision* of Isaiah? (Isaiah 2:1-3)

- 2) What will be the relationship of Zion (Jerusalem) with the nations of the world in this prophetic vision? (Isaiah 2:2,3)

- 3) In this end-time vision of Isaiah, who will be personally dwelling and ruling from the House of the Lord (i.e., the temple) on mount Zion? (Isaiah 2:3-4)

- 4) What illustration in verse 4 does Isaiah use to indicate that there will be peaceful conditions? (2:4)

- 5) What will Messiah (King Jesus) be doing from His throne for the people and nations according to verses 3 and 4?

- 6) What appeal is made to all the inhabitants of Judah and Jerusalem? (2:5)

- 7) This appeal went out because of the disobedient and rebellious behavior of the people. What sinful conduct and actions are specifically mentioned in verses 6-8?

- 8) In today's world, how would you compare similar actions that are taking place? Give specifics.

- 9) Isaiah warns the people of the terror of the Lord's judgment on their unrepentant rebellion and sin. When it comes, where they will seek to hide? (vv. 10, 19, 21)

- 10) What sin is repeatedly condemned in verses 11, 12, 17?

11) What images did Isaiah use to describe the arrogant men "against" whom God had set Himself? (2:12-15)

12) What did Isaiah prophecy about the actions of the people with the idols they had trusted in? (2:20-21)

13) What caution did Isaiah preach to God's people before it was too late in verse twenty-two? (Isaiah 2:22)

14) List two other verses that promise peace when the Lord establishes His Kingdom on earth?

15) How can you prepare for the coming "Day of the Lord"?

16) As a nation today, what message is given to us in this chapter?
