## Isaiah Chapter 7

1) In verse 1, the kings of what two nations came up against Jerusalem during the reign of wicked King Ahaz? (1) [On king Ahaz see 2 Kings 16:1-4]

2) How did King Ahaz and those in Jerusalem respond to the news of this threat? (2)

3) God sent the prophet Isaiah along with his son to deliver a message to king Ahaz. What was the name of Isaiah's son?

Extra credit: What was the meaning of Isaiah's son's name?

4) What word of instruction did God send to Ahaz, what was he NOT to do? (3,4)

5) According to verses 7-9, what should be the king's response to this threat? (9)

6) What did God invite Ahaz to do in order to reassure himself of God's faithfulness for deliverance? (10)

7) How did the prophet Isaiah react to Ahaz's refusal to ask for a sign? (13,14)

8) God Himself would supply the sign. What was to be the sign according to verse 14?

9) What will be significant concerning the age of this child and the deliverance God would provide? (15,16)

10) What country would be used by God to punish both Judah and its enemies in these verses? That is, who would eventually come to punish the nation's unrepentant sin? (17-20)

11) What would be the impact on the nation's agriculture and prosperity following God's divine punishment? (see, 23-25)

12) Who in particular will remain and eat curds and honey after the warfare is past? (15,21,22)
