38. Luke 22:56. Who accused Peter of being a follower of Jesus?
39. Luke 22:57. How did Peter respond to her accusation?
40. Luke 22:56-60. How many times did Peter deny he was a follower of Jesus? (cf. v.34).
41. Luke 22:61-62. After the rooster crowed in fulfillment of Jesus' words, what did Peter do?
42. Luke 22:63-65. How did those who held Jesus in custody treat Him?
43. Luke 22:66. Early the next day the Ruling Counsel assembled. Luke records what 2 questions that were asked of Jesus?
