

Book of Luke Chapter 22

Read Luke 22:1-6

1. Luke 1: What feast day was anticipated by the people?
2. Luke 22:2. What was the plan of the chief priests and teachers of the law?
3. Luke 22:3. What was Satan's role in the events that unfolded?
4. Luke 22:4-5. How did the leaders respond to Judas's willingness to betray Jesus?
5. Luke 22:5. What did Judas get in return for betraying Jesus?
6. Luke 22:6. What, then, was Judas' *plan* for his betrayal of Jesus?
7. Luke 22:6. Why was it important for Judas to hand Jesus over "*when no crowd was present*"?

Read Luke 22:7-38

7. Luke 22:8-13. What instructions for the Passover did Jesus give to Peter and John?
8. Luke 22:15-16. Why did Jesus eagerly desire to eat the Passover with His disciples?
9. Luke 22:15-16. What was the significance and meaning of the Passover celebration? (Review Exodus 12; especially verses 2, 12-14, 26-27).
10. Luke 22:16. What did Jesus mean when He said, "*I will not eat it (i.e., the Passover) again until it finds fulfillment in the kingdom of God*"? (Hint: Passover celebrated God's redemption (and His deliverance) of His people)

11. Luke 22:17-20. What did Jesus instruct His disciples to do in remembrance of Him?

12. Luke 22:19-20. What did the unleavened bread and the cup represent?

13. Luke 22:20. According to verse 20, what else would be accomplished by the shedding of Jesus' blood?

14. Luke 22:23-24. What dispute arose among Jesus' disciples?

15. Luke 22:25-27. What principle did Jesus apply in response to the disciples' disagreement? (25-27; also, John 13 – 16 speak of this same time. How does Jesus' servant actions in John 13:4f reinforce the principle and set the example?)

16. Luke 22:31. What did Jesus tell His disciples about the desires of Satan for them?

17. Luke 22:32. Jesus specifically focused His address on Peter. What did He tell Peter? What did He prophecy concerning Peter? (32)

18. Luke 22:33. How did Peter respond to the words of Jesus?

19. Luke 22:35-37. The ministry of Jesus' disciples was about to change (that is, after Jesus' departure). What would they now need that they had not needed before?

20. Luke 22:38. How many swords did Jesus say were sufficient for His purpose?
