- 15. For what did Jesus mildly reprimand them? (25)
- 16. What did Jesus say had been revealed in Scripture, and was "necessary" for Messiah? (26)
- 17. What did Jesus do to convince them this was God's perfect plan? (27)

18. Why did Jesus explain the Scriptures to the men? (27)

Read Luke 24:28-35

- 19. When did the men finally recognize Jesus? (29-31)
- 20. Who opened their eyes? (31) Who had earlier kept their eyes closed? (16)
- 21. How are we to understand God's ways from these two verses (16,31)? And what do we learn from this? (Consider verse 45, as well)
- 22. How did Jesus leave them? (31)
- 23. What does this tell us about Christ's resurrected body?

- 24. How did Jesus try to calm and reassure the disciples? (38-43)
- 25. Why did Jesus ask for something to eat? (41) What did they give Jesus to eat? (42)
- 26. What was needed for the disciples to finally and rightly understand the prophecies about Christ in Scripture? (44-45)
- 27. What instructions did Jesus give to His disciples? (46-48)
- 28. What was the "power from on high" to which Jesus referred? (49; see Acts 1:8-11)
