

## **PSALM 119** – VVBC Congregational Project

### GODLINESS IS:

- v.1: endeavoring to live life intentionally, in God's presence to please Him  
walking according to the word of the Lord  
being undefiled; walking in the law of the Lord  
blamelessness before God, which requires a sinless atoning sacrifice
- v.2: seeking Him with the whole heart (wholeheartedly)  
blessed by our obedience
- v.3: keeping God's commands with respect and not be ashamed  
keeping His commandments; walking in His ways
- v.5: dependence on God's help and power to live for Him, and not my own  
steadfast in obeying God's word  
keeping God's commands
- v.6: keeping/respecting God's commandments  
fixing your eyes on the commandments
- v.7: being upright in heart  
learning God's righteous judgments  
praising God with a whole upright heart
- v.8: the saved He never leaves
- v.9: guarding my way by knowing God's word  
taking heed to God's word  
guarding your heart
- v.10: seeking God with your whole heart  
humility before God that asks His help to live and stay obedient  
not wandering from God's word
- v.11: memorizing and storing up God's word in my heart so I might not sin  
studying scripture and putting it into action  
hiding God's word in my heart  
hiding His word in my heart and reminding myself not to sin
- v.14: rejoicing in obeying God's word as one rejoices in great riches  
rejoicing in and valuing the word of God
- v.15: meditating and pondering God's word and ways  
meditating on God's word with respect  
meditating on God's precepts

## GODLINESS IS: continued ...

- v.16: living by a commitment to not forget God's word  
delighting in God's word  
not forgetting God's word
- v.17: serving the Lord obediently and faithfully  
dealing with us to help us keep His word
- v.18: seeing wonderful things in God's word  
seeing the beauty in following God's law
- v.19: a sojourner's mindset that my home and treasure is not in this world
- v.20: a longing to know and follow God's word at all time
- v.21: being rebuked to help us and accepting His rebuke
- v.24: delighting in God's word and letting it be my counselor  
delighting in God's testimonies
- v.25: having humility before God  
cling to the Lord  
receiving life through His word
- v.26: declaring our ways so the God can teach us
- v.27: looking to God to help me understand His word  
understanding God's ways and meditating on His wonderful deeds
- v.28: having Godly sorrow that leads to repentance  
being willing to be strengthened by His word
- v.29: keeping from deceitful ways  
being true to the word of God  
no more lying, being truthful  
not lying, but being honest and getting more from His law  
putting away false ways
- v.30: choosing the way of faithfulness and setting one's heart on His word  
choosing truth
- v.31: holding fast to God's word
- v.32: running in the path of God's commandments  
experiencing an enlarged heart

## GODLINESS IS: continued ...

- v.33: prayerfully seeking God's help to learn and live by His word
- v.34: seeking to gain Godly understanding  
obeying God's word with my whole heart
- v.36: seeking God and His word, not selfish gain  
putting faith in God's ways not monetary gain  
not coveting  
holding to God's testimonies more than to anything else
- v.37: rejecting vanity  
monitoring the intake of our eyes
- v.40: revived in the Lord through His word
- v.42: having an answer to give to one who criticizes my trust in Godliness  
trusting in God's word
- v.43: trusting His word
- v.44: keeping God's law  
keeping God's laws forever (always)
- v.45: life in a "wide place;" one of truest freedom and liberty
- v.46: telling others about God and not being afraid  
speaking openly of God's word  
telling others without shame
- v.47: learning, loving, and living the commandments of God  
having a deep love for God's word
- v.49: hope in Christ
- v.50: His comfort from His word
- v.51: faithfully following the God's word even at the insults of others  
staying true to God's word even though you are mocked
- v.52: making a commitment to God to NOT forget His word  
remembering God's word in times of need ministers His comfort
- v.55: keeping God's principles and applying them

## GODLINESS IS: continued ...

- v.54: singing God's songs is like comforting words from home  
remembering our hopes and dreams are not in this life
- v.58: seeking the Lord with all your heart
- v.59: considering my ways and then turning my feet to your word  
thoughtful living
- v.60: keeping His commandments quickly and always
- v.62: keeping my eyes focused on the Lord  
praying 24/7
- v.63: being in the company of Christians (i.e., those desiring Godliness)  
choosing right friends and companions
- v.64: God's mercy is everywhere
- v.66: learn from God's word and use good judgment from His teachings  
learning good judgment and knowledge
- v.68: being good and doing good, like our heavenly Father
- v.70: delighting in His law helps in affliction
- v.71: to see God's hand in adversity and know His purposes are good
- v.72: putting God's word above all earthly treasures
- v.75: staying faithful to the Lord
- v.76: feeling comfort in God's love  
being loved by God
- v.80: a heart clean and blameless before Him  
having one's heart solid with the Lord and so not ashamed
- v.81: putting your hope in God's word
- v.82: looking to God's word as your comforter
- v.84: turning to the Lord when you are persecuted
- v.88: obeying the Lord  
being revived in Him so that His commandments may be kept  
being prompted (quicken) by His love and willing to keep His word

## GODLINESS IS: continued ...

- v.89: finding strength in God's eternal word  
seeing God's faithfulness to all generations  
an allegiance to eternal truth
- v.90: a life of service to God
- v.92: delighting in God's law  
when I delight in God's law
- v.93: commitment to never forget God's precepts  
never forgetting God's precepts  
"life" if we remember God's precepts and meditate daily on them  
true life that can only come through God's word
- v.94: knowing 'I am His'  
seeking God in all things
- v.95: considering God's testimonies
- v.97: meditating on God's law  
loving God's law and meditating on it throughout the day  
keeping God's word in mind, don't hide it away
- v.98: allowing God's teachings to guide us  
wisdom if we mediate daily and keep His precepts (also, 97,99)
- v.99: having more understanding
- v.100: an understanding that leads to keeping God's precepts
- v.101: refraining from every evil way  
avoiding paths of temptation  
holding back your feet from every evil way in order to keep His word  
self-discipline to make right choices in life
- v.103: enjoying your time with God
- v.104: hating and rejecting every false, wrong path or way
- v.105: being illuminated by God's word  
God's word is like a map  
following God's word in the darkest of times  
walking with God's guidance (His word)

## GODLINESS IS: continued ...

- v.106:      keeping God's righteous judgments  
              keeping God's ordinances  
              a commitment to live Godly no matter what
- v.108:      singing praises to the Lord  
              offering praise to God as a free-will offering from the heart  
              a life of lifting up praise to God freely and often
- v.109:      remembering God's law
- v.111:      building a heritage that honors the Lord  
              when God's testimonies are the joy of your heart
- v.112:      applying God's word to one's own life  
              inclining one's heart to perform God's statutes
- v.113:      staying on God's path for you  
              loving God's law  
              not a double-minded life; but with eyes fixed on the Lord
- v.114:      relying on God's protection  
              looking to God when troubles arise  
              hope in God's word  
              when I allow God's word to be my hiding place and shield
- v.116:      being not ashamed of the Christian hope  
              not being ashamed of God's word
- v.117:      confidence of being held in the hand of God (safety)
- v.120:      fear of not keeping your word  
              fearing God and His judgments  
              having a fear of God's judgments  
              giving God His rightful place ... fear His judgments and humble myself  
              living life in the fear of the Lord
- v.121:      doing what is just and right
- v.123:      longing for salvation and for God's word of righteousness  
              anticipating always the soon arrival of the "Blessed Hope"
- v.125:      being God's servant  
              being His and being taught by Him  
              a continual desire for God's word  
              learning to understand and apply God's word to our daily lives

## GODLINESS IS: continued ...

- v.127: loving God's laws and following them  
obedience comes before all  
loving God's commandments more than fine gold
- v.128: hating falsehood  
hating (rejecting) every false way
- v.132: loving God's name  
loving God and His mercy for us  
loving the name of the Lord
- v.133: directing one's steps by God's word  
allowing no iniquity gets dominion over you  
not being dominated by any sin
- v.134: deliverance from evil in order to keep God's ways
- v.135: looking to Jesus and learning to keep His ways
- v.136: concern for those living in sin  
crying over others not keeping God's commandments  
when I have righteous sorrow for those who do not keep God's word
- v.137: relying on God's righteousness, not one's own
- v.139: having a zeal for God's words  
when I love the truth
- v.140: loving God's pure word
- v.141: not forgetting God's word
- v.143: when God's word is my delight
- v.145: in times of need crying out to the Lord  
keeping God's word
- v.147: meditating on God's word early in the morning and late at night(v.148)  
being in a constant state of God-awareness
- v.148: setting you mind to always turn to a study of God's word
- v.149: spiritual revival by God's word

## GODLINESS IS: continued ...

- v.151:      being near the Lord  
              being close to God and believing His commandments are true
- v.153:      even in difficult times turn to the Lord and remember His words (157)
- v.156:      trusting in God's mercy and forgiving
- v.157:      sticking to following God's word, not matter what
- v.158:      being grieved over transgressors
- v.159:      loving God's precepts and being revived by Him
- v.160:      believing God's word is always true
- v.162:      rejoicing in God's word
- v.163:      hating falsehood (lies) but loving God's word  
              abhorring lying
- v.164:      praising God
- v.165:      having great peace that comes from loving God's word  
              finding peace and comfort in time with the Lord  
              having peace within (Isaiah 26:3)
- v.169:      pursuing understanding of God's word
- v.171:      being excited and diligent to tell others of God (also, 129,172)
- v.172:      singing God's word
- v.173:      making God's word your guidepost
- v.174:      delighting in God's word
- v.176:      remembering God's ways when one goes astray  
              we all falter but always turn to the Lord when we do
