Foremost blessings summarized:

- 2. The New Jerusalem (21:9-27)
  - The place Jesus Christ has prepared for His bride (all those "in Christ") -
  - The glory and radiance of the City is the glory and radiance of God Himself (cf. 21:10-11; cf. 4:3)
  - The purpose of the wall is not to defend the city, but a constant reminder of the city's eternal security (RT, 462)
  - The city's gates are actually "gate-towers." The word for "gate" resides within the Gk. word used.
  - 12 gate-towers speaks of open access (cf. Ark, Tabernacle, Temple) -
  - 12 angels are not for protection, rather they signal the divine presence -
  - The City memorializes God chosen nation. (v.12; cf. the 12 tribes/gates) -
  - The City rests on the Earth, indicated by its foundation (not suspended)
  - The foundation is likely horizontally diverse with precious stones (vv.19)
  - The City is a cube of 1400-1500 miles each direction. The wall  $\sim$ 220 ft -
  - The Wall radiates the glory of God as well (like Jasper), the City of gold that resembles transparent glass
  - No Sun, no moon, no night, nothing unclean only those in the Bk of Life
