Chapter 10 Questions:

- 2) Some in Corinth suggested Paul was walking according to what? (10:2)
- 3) Paul wrote the Corinthians “*For though we walk in the flesh, we do not do what according to the flesh?*” (10:3)
- 4) A Christian’s weapons are not of what kind? (10:4)
- 5) What is the source that makes the believer’s weapons of warfare mighty? (10:4)
- 6) A Christian’s weapons of warfare are mighty for destroying what? (10:4).
- 7) Name 2 things that must be cast down that are raised against the knowledge of God. (10:5)

- 8) What must be taken captive to make it obedient to Christ? (10:5)
- 9) What does Paul remind the Corinthians that they both share? (10:7)
- 10) The Lord gave Paul authority not for the destruction of the Corinthians but to do what? (10:8)
- 11) Some in Corinth said Paul’s letters were weighty and powerful. What did they say about his bodily presence? (10:10)
- 12) What did some in Corinth say about Paul’s speech? (10:10)
- 13) In verse 11, Paul wrote to the Corinthians: “*What we say in words when absent by letter, the same we will do when we are what?*” (10:11)
- 14) What does Paul say about those who measure themselves *by* one another and compare themselves *with* one another? (10:12)

15) Paul reminds the Corinthians that he and those with him had previously come a long distance to bring them what? (10:14)

16) As the faith of the Corinthians increases, what does Paul say is his hope? (10:15-16)

17) Finish this quote, “*But he who glories (ESV, boasts), let him glory (or, boast) _____.*” (10:17)
