- 3) What four (4) things does Paul say about the churches in Macedonia? (8:2)

- 4) In spite of great affliction suffered by the churches in Macedonia what emotion did they feel? (8:2)
- 5) Out of deep poverty how did the Macedonian churches respond to the freewill offering Paul was collecting for persecuted believers in Jerusalem? (8:2)
- 6) Who gave "not only according to their means," but beyond their means (or, their "power"; i.e., far beyond any expectation)? (8:3-5)
- 7) What had the churches in Macedonia given before they gave their material possessions? (8:5)
- 8) Who was in Corinth at the time the plan began for the collection of a love offering for the poor saints in Jerusalem? (8:6)
- 9) Who does Paul say excelled in faith, speech, knowledge, in diligence and love? (8:7)
- 10) Paul did not command the Corinthians to give to the poor saints in Jerusalem, but their generous giving would show the sincerity of their Christian faith and love to whom? (8:8)
- 11) According to Paul who had been rich and become poor so that the Corinthians might be rich? (8:9)
- 12) How long had the Corinthians "a readiness of mind" to give to the poor saints at Jerusalem? (8:10)

- 13) Paul commended the Corinthian church for their desire to give to this needly cause. Now he calls on them to do what? (8:10,11)

- 19) In Macedonia, Paul received from the churches their collections for the saints in Jerusalem. Also, the churches sent representatives with Paul to safely accompany the collection. In verse 22, Paul refers to these brothers in Christ as "______ of the churches." (8:23)
- 20) In verse 23, how does Paul refer to Titus? (8:23)
- 21) What was the Corinthian church to show Titus and the "messengers of the churches" when they arrive in Corinth? (8:24)
