

A Time Table of the Flood Waters

Genesis Chapters 7 and 8

Noah's precisely dates the *rising* and *receding* flood waters:

1. (7:4) The Flood's beginning announced → 2nd mo., 10th day, Noah **600th** year
2. (7:11) Flood **begins**, waters *increase* → 2nd mo., 17th day (1 week later)
3. (7:17) The Flood waters *prevail* → 40 days later
Rain ceased falling
4. (8:2-4) The Flood waters **recede**, → 7th mo., 17th day (5 mos./150 days)
All water sources have closed
5. (8:3-5) Mountain tops become visible → 10th mo., 1st day
The ark resting on Ararat
6. (8:6-9) Raven sent out and dove → 40 days later
7. (8:10) Dove sent out 2nd time → 7 days later (1 week later)
8. (8:12) Dove sent out 3rd time → 7 days later again (1 week later)
9. (8:13) Waters dried up off the land → 1st mo., 1st day, Noah 601
10. (8:14) God commands Noah: "**go out**" → 2nd mo., 27th day, **370** days in all!

A Summary Chronology

7 th mo., 17 th day; Flood <u>Recedes</u>	150

1 st mo., 1 st day (A New Year)	314
2 nd mo., 27 th day; <u>Noah Departs</u>	370 Days of the Flood
