- 6) On what day did Jesus heal this man? (John 5:9)

- 7) What complaint did the Jews make to the cured man and why? (John 5:10)

- 8) Give 2 reasons why the cured man at the pool could not point out Jesus to the Jews. (John 5:11-13)

- 9) Where did the cured man from the pool see Jesus next? (John 5:14)

- 10) To whom did Jesus say, "See, you are well! Sin no more, that nothing worse may happen to you." (ESV) and where? (John 5:14)

The Authority of the Son

- 11) Why did the Jews persecute and try to slay Jesus after he healed the man at the pool? (John 5:16)

- 12) What increased the Jews anger against Jesus after the man was healed on the Sabbath? (John 5:17-18)

- 13) What would Jesus do that would cause the Jews to marvel? (John 5:20)

- 14) Tell two things both the Father and Son do as recorded in. (John 5:21)

15) Who shall escape condemnation according to Jesus' words? (John 5:24)

16) According to Jesus what voice were the dead to hear? (John 5:25)

17) Who now has the authority to give life to others? (John 5:26)

18) What shall those in their graves do when they hear His voice? (John 5:29)

19) Give the 2 destinies for those in their graves when they hear his voice and come forth. (John 5:29)

20) Whose "will" was Jesus doing? (John 5:30)

Testimonies About Jesus

21) One witness doesn't have much credibility whether the testimony is true or not. The Bible has many references to the need for 2 or 3 witnesses to prove something is true. (i.e. Deut 19:15, Numbers 35:30, 2 Cor 13:1) The statement of verse 31 in John is saying there are other witnesses that provide proof.

Who said, "If I alone bear witness about myself, my testimony is not true." (John 5:31)

27) Since the Jews refused to honor Jesus as God's Son, what did Jesus know about them? (John 5:42)

28) Jesus told the Jews He would not accuse them to the Father. Name the one who accused them. (John 5:45)
