Jesus at the Feast of Booths

- 5) What reason did Jesus give his brethren for not attending the Feast of Tabernacles when he was traveling in Galilee? (John 7:8)

- 6) In what way did Jesus finally attend the Feast of Tabernacles? (John 7:10)

- 7) Who sought Jesus during the Feast of Tabernacles? (John 7:11)

- 8) Tell two things the people said about Jesus during the Feast of Tabernacles? (John 7:12)

- 9) About the midst of the Feast of Tabernacles where did Jesus go and why? (John 7:14)

- 10) According to Jesus what indicates that a man seeks his own glory? (John 7:18)

- 11) During the Feast of Tabernacles as Jesus taught in the temple what did the people accuse Jesus of having? (John 7:20)

- 12) On what day of the week were the Jews performing circumcision? (7:22)

- 13) Why did Jews of Jesus’ day circumcise on the Sabbath day? (John 7:22-23)

- 14) What constitutes unrighteous judgment? (John 7:24)

15) Give the word describing how Jesus spoke in the temple during the Feast of Tabernacles even though the Jewish rulers sought his life. (John 7:26)

16) As Jesus taught in the temple during the Feast of Tabernacles, no man laid hands on him even though the Jews sought to kill him. Why? (John 7:30)

Officers Sent to Arrest Jesus

17) Give two groups who sent officers to take Jesus while he taught in the temple during the Feast of Tabernacles. (John 7:32)

18) Tell the announcement Jesus made to the officers sent by the Pharisees and chief priests to take him at the temple during the Feast of Tabernacles. (John 7:32-33)

19) During the Feast of Tabernacles when the officers came to take Jesus in the temple, what two things did Jesus say they would be unable to achieve? (John 7:34-38)

Rivers of Living Water

20) How far along was the Feast of Tabernacles when Jesus said, "If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink." (John 7:37)

21) What does Jesus say shall flow out of the belly of believers? (John 7:38)

22) Give another word for "rivers of living water." (John 7:39)

23) Why had not the Holy Ghost (Spirit) been given to Jesus' believer when he spoke about "rivers of living water" in the temple during the Feast of Tabernacles? (John 7:39)

Division Among the People

24) Give 4 responses of the people when Jesus spoke about "rivers of living water" on the last day of the Feast of Tabernacles. (John 7:40)

25) What were two results among the people concerning Jesus the last day of the Feast of Tabernacles? (John 7:43)

26) Give the officers answer to the Pharisees and chief priests question, “Why have ye not brought him,” upon their return from the temple during the Feast of Tabernacles. (John 7:45)

27) Who thought the officers had been deceived by Jesus when they returned from the temple during the Feast of Tabernacles? (John 7:47)

28) Upon whom did the Pharisees pronounce a curse when the officers returned from the temple during the Feast of Tabernacles? (John 7:49)

29) Who spoke these words, “Doth our law judge any man, before it hear him, and know what he doeth?” (John 7:50-51)

30) Who spoke the following words and to whom, “Art thou also of Galilee? Search and look: for out of Galilee ariseth no prophet.” (John 7:52)

NOTE: The earliest manuscripts do not include 7:53-8:11. Chapter 8:1-11 is story of woman caught in adultery.
