EXODUS 12 OUTLINE

- 1. **Preparation for Passover** (Verses 1-11)
 - Instructions for selecting and preparing the lamb (Verses 3-5)
 - Instructions for applying the blood on doorframes (Verse 7)
 - Instructions for roasting the meat and eating it with bitter herbs (Verse 8)
 - Instructions for eating the Passover lamb with cloak tucked into belt, sandals on feet, and staff in hand (Verse 11)
- 2. The LORD's Passover (Verses 12-30)
 - The LORD strikes down the firstborn of both people and animals in Egypt (Verse 12)
 - The Israelites are commanded to eat bread made without yeast for seven days during the Festival of Unleavened Bread (Verse 15)
 - The name of the celebration to remember the LORD bringing Israel's divisions out of Egypt is the Festival of the Unleavened Bread (Verse 17)
 - The LORD strikes down all the firstborn in Egypt at midnight (Verse 29)
 - No Egyptian house was without someone who died during Passover (Verse 30)
- 3. The Exodus (Verses 31-51)
 - The Egyptians urge the Israelites to leave Egypt, fearing that they would all die (Verse 33)
 - The Israelites carry dough without yeast wrapped in clothing (Verse 34)
 - About six hundred thousand Israelite men journey from Rameses to Sukkoth (Verse 37)
 - The Israelites' dough had no yeast as a result of being driven out of Egypt without time to prepare food (Verse 39)
 - The Israelites lived in Egypt for 430 years (Verse 40)
 - Regulations for the Passover meal, including who can and cannot eat it (Verses 43-48)
 - Instructions for eating the Passover meal inside the house (Verse 46)
 - Foreigners living among the Israelites must have all males in their household circumcised to celebrate Passover (Verse 48)
