Psalm 33:1-12

The first three verses of this Psalm urge us to offer up worship to our LORD, both with singing and on musical instruments. That's followed by four verses giving us some of the reasons why we should worship him; because of his glorious attributes and the wonders of his creation.

In verse eight we see a command for all people to fear the LORD, followed by three verses explaining why we should stand in awe of his mighty power displayed in creation and in his control of all things.

Finally, in verse twelve God reveals that there is a special blessing for the nation whose God is the LORD, and yet even that comes about according to his sovereign will.
